




Operations & Safety Update

Safety

Downtown Partnership of Baltimore (DPOB) provides a comprehensive set of safety services that utilize our in-house staff, private security contractors, and public law enforcement agencies at every level.

Downtown Partnership Guides

20 uniformed ambassadors check in on businesses, assist pedestrians and visitors, and provide an extra layer of safety services.

Monday - Sunday, 7am - 7:30pm

Wolf Security

Eight unarmed private security officers.

Monday - Friday, 12 - 8pm

Baltimore City School Police Officers

Four uniformed officers assigned per day.

Monday - Sunday, 4 - 10pm

Eight officers total on Friday - Saturday, 4pm - 12am

Maryland State Police

Four marked Maryland State Police Officers.

Monday - Sunday, 6 - 10pm

AVERAGE NUMBER OF INCIDENTS PER MONTH HAS STEADILY DECREASED



GOOD NEWS! Our increased safety services are paying off! Crime is down year-over-year, and the average number of monthly incidents in the DMA continues to go down. (See chart, next page) Just in time for more visitors and office workers are returning to Downtown.



Safety (cont.)

In 2021, Downtown Baltimore has seen a reduction in incidents for all four most common crime categories.

Common Assault	-16.1%
Larceny	-15.4%
Larceny (Auto)	-18.8 %
Agg. Assault	- 38.9%

Park Safe

It just takes one culprit to drive up larceny from autos. We're monitoring activity of this type near the Marriott Inner Harbor. Roughly half of all incidents happen inside garages, and the majority happen overnight.

Take your valuables with you when you park car!

Clean

Downtown Partnership empties over 300 trashcans daily, cleans the sidewalks and street cuts, and maintains public plazas and alleys 365 days a year.

Current Area of Focus: Alleys

In the past 12 months, DPOB has launched an alleyway initiative, aimed at getting our highly visible but underutilized spaces up to code with permitted dumpsters, increased lighting, increased trash removal, power washing, and plans for adding public art. In the next few months, keep an eye out for alley glow-ups with an infusion of local, public art.
